## OATLEY AND NEIGHBOURS AT THE TIME OF THE ARMISTICE - 1918

The Armistice to conclude World War 1 was signed on 11<sup>th</sup> November 1918.What was it like to live in Oatley at that time? A way of gauging the nature of the time is to search the local newspapers. There were two weekly papers: The St George Call and the Hurstville Propeller, both cost a penny.

Copies of relevant editions of these papers are now online through the website Trove. A search reveals a wealth of information, poetry, comment and editorial as well as some photos. Weekly casualty lists are shown as well as correspondence.
